Infirmery Units Recognized for Preventing CLABSI

Providing the best patient care is our top goal, and reducing central line infections continues to be a priority to achieve that goal. That's why Polly Davenport, , challenged units at the Infirmery to go the entire Razorback season (84 days) without a CLABSI. The 11 units recognized for completing the CLABSI challenge are: **4N**—547 days, **CVSD**—429 days, **2E**—318 days, **NSICU**—312 days, **7E**—298 days, **5E**—268 days, **4W**—191 days, **2NW**—153 days, **4E**—125 days, **4NE**—125 days, **4NW**—103 days.

Calvary Cemetery Baby Area Rededicated

In 2005, Fr. Leo Reidmueller began the process of creating grave sites for babies born too soon for viability (20 weeks gestation). Due to the deterioration of the temporary markers and their continual replacement, Fr. George proposed to update the site with permanent marble markers containing Scripture verses. The project was completed in 2017 and blessed earlier this month.
